Kia ora,

With the implementation of the Covid passport system starting on Friday 3 December, Rotorua Energy Events Centre has advised they will be following the Protection Framework Guidelines. Rotorua Basketball Association (RBA) needs to ensure we follow their requirements and the requirements of the Government.

With that, all RBA activities (trainings & 3x3 competition) will be following "Fully Vaccinated" protocols, which allows us up to 100 participants with 1m distancing for spectators. Note:

- Children under the age of 12yrs 3 months are treated as if they have a vaccine pass.
- All others over 12yrs 3 months must have a vaccination pass

Please be aware that without a Covid Passport, you will not be able to enter the Sportsdrome facility.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Are there alternative options to a Vaccine Pass that will allow someone to enter the Sportsdrome? i.e., a negative COVID-19 test?

Not at present under the COVID-19 Protection Framework.

How do I get a vaccine pass?

Once you have been vaccinated you can create a "My COVID Record" by visiting <u>mycovidrecord.health.nz</u>. Once you are logged in you can request an electronic pass or hard-copy certificate.

Do children require Vaccine Passes?

Currently under the COVID-19 Protection Framework, anyone 12 years and 3 months can be vaccinated and can access their COVID-19 vaccination records through the "My COVID Record" <u>website</u>.

Therefore, anyone over 12 years and 3 months is required to show a valid Vaccine Pass to enter. Children under this age are currently not eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine and therefore won't need to produce one to enter.

I've had one vaccine; can I still visit a Rotorua Energy Events Centre?

Currently under the COVID-19 Protection Framework, anyone entering the Sportsdrome must have received both vaccines and these need to be valid. After 6 months a booster shot is required to keep your Vaccine Pass valid.

I'm exempt from vaccinations; can I still visit Rotorua Energy Events Centre?

If you are unable to be vaccinated due to medical reasons, you can still get a Vaccine Pass based on your exemption. For more information on this process visit the <u>Ministry of Health website</u>.
